- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) (1) The Board shall issue refunds as specified in this section.
- 2 (2) Unless authorized by the Board or under subsection (b) of this section, a refund may not exceed the amount paid into the Trust by the account holder.
- 4 (b) A refund equal to the same benefits as provided by the prepaid contract, 5 minus any amount paid out of the funds of the Trust on behalf of the qualified 6 beneficiary and for reasonable administrative charges, shall be made if the 7 beneficiary:
- 8 (1) [Graduates early from college or is] **IS** awarded a scholarship or tuition remission that covers benefits provided under the prepaid contract; or
- 10 (2) Dies or suffers from a disability which prevents the beneficiary 11 from attending an institution of higher education within the time allowed by this 12 subtitle.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
