14 15	(a) (1) There shall be a statewide primary election in every even–numbered year.
16	(2) A primary election shall be held:
17 18	(i) in the year in which the Governor is elected, on the [second Tuesday after the first Monday] FIRST TUESDAY in [September] JUNE; and

- 1 (ii) in the year in which the President of the United States is 2 elected, on the first Tuesday in March.
- 3 (b) In Baltimore City, there shall be a primary election for municipal offices 4 on the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September in the year following 5 the election of the Governor.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2007.
