## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law - Primary Elections - Election Dates**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the date on which the primary election in a certain year  
4 shall be held; and generally relating to primary elections.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - Election Law**

13 8-201.

14 (a) (1) There shall be a statewide primary election in every  
15 even-numbered year.

16 (2) A primary election shall be held:

17 (i) in the year in which the Governor is elected, on the [second  
18 Tuesday after the first Monday] **FIRST TUESDAY** in [September] **JUNE**; and

1                   (ii)    in the year in which the President of the United States is  
2 elected, on the first Tuesday in March.

3           (b)    In Baltimore City, there shall be a primary election for municipal offices  
4 on the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September in the year following  
5 the election of the Governor.

6           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 2007.
