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Vehicle Laws – Special Registration Plates – Maryland's Native Heritage and Culture

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration, in consultation with 5 the Cedarville Band of Piscataway Indians, to develop and make available for certain vehicles a special registration plate to honor Maryland's native heritage 6 7 and culture; authorizing certain persons to apply to the Administration for the 8 special registration plate for certain classes of vehicles; requiring the owner of a 9 vehicle issued a special registration plate under this Act to pay certain fees; 10 establishing that certain vehicles are exempt from paying certain fees; prohibiting certain fees from being credited to the Gasoline and Motor Vehicle 11 12 Revenue Account; requiring the Administration to consult with the Cedarville Band of Piscataway Indians on the design of the special registration plates, the 13 fee to be charged, and a schedule for the transfer of revenue collected to the 14 Cedarville Band of Piscataway Indians; requiring the Administration to adopt 15 16 certain regulations; and generally relating to special registration plates 17 honoring Maryland's native heritage and culture.

- 3 (A) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE CEDARVILLE BAND OF PISCATAWAY
 4 INDIANS THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE FOR
 5 QUALIFYING VEHICLES A SPECIALLY DESIGNED REGISTRATION PLATE
 6 HONORING MARYLAND'S NATIVE HERITAGE AND CULTURE.
- 7 (B) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER A

 7 UNDER § 13–903 OF THIS TITLE.
- 8 (3) No portion of the fee collected under this section 9 MAY BE CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE REVENUE 10 ACCOUNT FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 8–403 OR § 8–404 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 11 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL CONSULT WITH THE CEDARVILLE 12 BAND OF PISCATAWAY INDIANS ON:
- 13 (1) THE DESIGN OF A REGISTRATION PLATE TO BE ISSUED UNDER 14 THIS SECTION TO HONOR MARYLAND'S NATIVE HERITAGE AND CULTURE;
- 15 (2) THE SETTING OF THE FEE TO BE CHARGED UNDER
 16 SUBSECTION (C)(1)(II) OF THIS SECTION AT A LEVEL INTENDED TO ENCOURAGE
 17 THE PURCHASE OF THE REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION
 18 WHILE PROVIDING A CONTINUOUS REVENUE SOURCE TO BENEFIT THE
 19 CEDARVILLE BAND OF PISCATAWAY INDIANS; AND
- 20 (3) A SCHEDULE UNDER WHICH THE ADMINISTRATION WILL 21 TRANSFER TO THE CEDARVILLE BAND OF PISCATAWAY INDIANS REVENUE 22 COLLECTED ON BEHALF OF THE CEDARVILLE BAND OF PISCATAWAY INDIANS.
- 23 **(E)** THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO GOVERN 24 THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.
