A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Driver Education Program Deaf and Hard of Hearing Access Fund

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain driver education schools to pay a certain fee to 4 the Motor Vehicle Administration; requiring the Administration to pay the fees 5 collected under this Act into the Driver Education Program Deaf and Hard of 6 Hearing Access Fund; establishing the Fund; establishing the purpose and 7 composition of the Fund; requiring the Governor's Office of the Deaf and Hard of 8 Hearing to administer the Fund; authorizing the Governor's Office of the Deaf 9 and Hard of Hearing to spend money in the Fund for certain purposes; altering a certain definition to provide that certain fees collected under this Act may not 10 be altered by the Administration; defining certain terms; and generally relating 11 to the Driver Education Program Deaf and Hard of Hearing Access Fund. 12

18 19 20 21	(b) "Driver education course" means a standardized course of instruction under a driver education program, adopted or approved by the Administration in consultation with the State Department of Education, intended to teach individuals to safely drive a noncommercial motor vehicle.
22 23 24 25	(c) "Driver education instructor" means an individual who has completed required certification courses and is certified by the Administration to teach a driver education course, whether or not the individual is required to be licensed under Title 15, Subtitle 8 of this article.
26 27 28 29	(d) "Driver education program" means the courses and learning activities designated by the Administration in consultation with the State Department of Education that an individual may be required to complete before obtaining a noncommercial driver's license under this title.

1 (e) "Driver education school" means a school approved by the Administration 2 to conduct driver education courses in accordance with this subtitle.

(F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF: 1 2 (1) FEES PAID BY DRIVER EDUCATION SCHOOLS TO THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER § 16–507 OF THIS SUBTITLE; 3 4 (2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND (3) MONEY RECEIVED BY THE FUND FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE. 5 6 (G) THE OFFICE MAY SPEND MONEY IN THE FUND TO ASSIST DEAF AND 7 HARD OF HEARING **INDIVIDUALS** IN **OBTAINING** COMMUNICATION 8 ACCOMMODATIONS WHEN TAKING MANDATORY DRIVER EDUCATION COURSES.
