- 1 (b) The penalty imposed under this section may not exceed \$10,000.
- 2 (c) All penalties collected under this section shall be distributed to the 3 Animal Health Fund established under § 3–117 of this subtitle.
- 4 (d) The Secretary shall adopt regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2007.
