11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (a) A person may not ship or transport into this State any colony or used bee 16 equipment that is not accompanied by the following documents:

- 17 (1) An entry permit, issued by the Department; and
- 18 (2) A valid inspection certificate that:

1 (i) Has been issued by an authorized apiary inspector of the 2 state of origin; and

3 (ii) [Based on an inspection by that inspector within the 4 preceding 2 months, states] **STATES** that the colony or equipment is disease free 5 **BASED ON AN INSPECTION BY THAT INSPECTOR WITHIN A TIME PERIOD AS** 6 **DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT**.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2007.
