A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Services – Maryland Correctional Enterprises – Construction**
3 **Training Programs**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Commissioner of Correction and the Chief
5 Executive Officer of Maryland Correctional Enterprises to provide training
6 programs to provide construction services for State correctional facilities;
7 providing for specified exemptions from State procurement laws; limiting the
8 cost of certain construction projects; and generally relating to construction
9 training programs of the Maryland Correctional Enterprises.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Correctional Services**

18 3–511.

19 (A) The Commissioner and Chief Executive Officer may develop programs to
20 provide services or produce goods used by:

6 (B) (1) **THE COMMISSIONER AND THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER,**
7 **WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY, MAY DEVELOP TRAINING PROGRAMS**
8 **TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, AS DEFINED IN TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 1**
9 **OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, FOR STATE**
10 **CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.**

11 (2) **THE PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF**
12 **THIS SUBSECTION ARE NOT SUBJECT TO:**

13 (I) **THE PROVISIONS OF § 3-515 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND**

14 (II) **THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION II OF THE STATE**
15 **FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, EXCEPT FOR § 11-101 OF THE STATE**
16 **FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.**

17 (3) **A CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS**
18 **SUBSECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$500,000 IN TOTAL COSTS AS DETERMINED BY**
19 **THE SECRETARY.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2007.
