- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 16 21–1125.
- 17 Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, a person may not drive a low 18 speed vehicle:
- (1) On a highway for which the posted maximum speed limit exceeds
 [30] 35 miles per hour;

On an expressway or another controlled access highway that is 1 (2)signed in accordance with § 21–313 of this title; 2 3 On a highway on which driving a low speed vehicle is prohibited by (3)a county or municipal ordinance; or 4 Across a highway for which the posted maximum speed limit 5 (4)exceeds 45 miles per hour, except at an intersection that is controlled by: 6 A traffic control signal; or 7 (i) 8 (ii) A stop sign at each approach to the intersection. 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2007.
