A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Operation of Low Speed Vehicles – Highway Restrictions**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain maximum speed limit for purposes of a certain
4 provision of law that prohibits the operation of a low speed vehicle on a highway
5 for which the maximum posted speed exceeds a certain limit; and generally
6 relating to on prohibition against driving low speed vehicles on certain
7 highways.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 21–1125.

17 Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, a person may not drive a low
18 speed vehicle:

19 (1) On a highway for which the posted maximum speed limit exceeds
20 **[30] 35** miles per hour;

1 (2) On an expressway or another controlled access highway that is
2 signed in accordance with § 21–313 of this title;

3 (3) On a highway on which driving a low speed vehicle is prohibited by
4 a county or municipal ordinance; or

5 (4) Across a highway for which the posted maximum speed limit
6 exceeds 45 miles per hour, except at an intersection that is controlled by:

7 (i) A traffic control signal; or

8 (ii) A stop sign at each approach to the intersection.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2007.
