Horse Racing Heritage Act

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a special fund for the distribution of certain State 4 lottery revenues to horse racing purses and bred funds; requiring that horse 5 racing purses and bred funds be increased according to a certain formula; 6 authorizing the Governor to request a certain deficiency appropriation under 7 certain conditions; requiring that all funds for purses and bred funds under this 8 Act be in addition to and not supplant certain other funds; establishing certain 9 conditions on the distribution of certain funds; and generally relating to lottery proceeds and purse and bred fund supplements for horse racing in the State. 10
