BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Personnel and Pensions Section 26–201 and 26–202(b)(1) Annotated Code of Maryland (2004 Replacement Volume and 2006 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Personnel and Pensions

- 22 (ii) who was employed by the Field Enforcement Division on 23 June 30, 1995 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 2002;
- 24 (iii) who was employed by the Maryland Transportation 25 Authority on June 30, 1997 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 26 2002;
- 27 (iv) who was employed by the Baltimore City Sheriff's 28 Department on June 30, 1997 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 29 2002:
