2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:4 **Chapter 178 of the Acts of 2004**5 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2004. ~~It shall remain effective for a period of 3~~ 5 years and, at the end of
7 September 30, ~~2007~~ 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
8 this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.}9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 July 1, 2007.
