- FOR the purpose of classifying black bears as nongame mammals; prohibiting the
 Department of Natural Resources from reducing the black bear population in
 the State with certain exceptions; prohibiting the Department from establishing
 an open season to hunt black bears; and generally relating to the prohibition of
 hunting black bears.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (f) "Forest game birds and mammals" means forest game birds (ruffed grouse and turkey) and forest game mammals ([black bears,] deer, fox squirrels,

- 4 [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, (A) **THE** Department may reduce the wildlife population in any county, election district, or 5 other identifiable area of the State after a thorough investigation reveals that 6 protected wildlife is seriously injurious to agricultural or other interests in the affected 7 8 area. The method of reducing the wildlife population is at the Department's discretion, 9 except that trapping is preferred whenever feasible. The Department shall dispose of 10 wildlife taken pursuant to the provisions of this section as the Department deems advisable. 11
- 12 **(B)** THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT REDUCE THE BLACK BEAR 13 POPULATION IN ANY AREA OF THE STATE EXCEPT:
- 14 (1) IN DEFENSE OF A PERSON, THE PROPERTY OF A PERSON, OR A
 15 DOMESTICATED ANIMAL ON THE PROPERTY OF A PERSON; AND
- 16 **(2) AFTER EXHAUSTING ALL NONLETHAL METHODS OF**17 **RESOLVING CHRONIC DOCUMENTED AGRICULTURAL DAMAGE OR DEPREDATION**18 **CAUSED BY THE BLACK BEAR.**

- 20 (a) (1) Pursuant to § 10–205 of this title, **AND SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH**21 **(2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,** the Department shall establish by regulation and publish by July 1 each year the open season to hunt forest and upland game birds and
- 23 mammals.
- 24 **(2)** THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ESTABLISH AN OPEN SEASON TO 25 HUNT BLACK BEARS.
- [(2)] (3) Except as provided under § 10–410 of this subtitle, the Department may not authorize hunting on a Sunday.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
