CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Agriculture – Crop Insurance Premium Program – Cost Share**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the Maryland Crop Insurance Premium Program to
4 include a certain cost share element in order to increase participation by
5 farmers in the State in the Federal Crop Insurance Program; authorizing the
6 Secretary of Agriculture to make a certain payment for certain qualifying crop
7 insurance products; prohibiting a cost share payment from exceeding a certain
8 amount; requiring the Secretary to submit a certain annual report to the
9 Governor and the General Assembly by a certain date; requiring the Secretary
10 to adopt certain regulations by a certain date; and generally relating to crop
11 insurance for farmers in the State.

12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 Article – Agriculture

14 Section 2–901 to be under the amended subtitle “Subtitle 9. Maryland Crop
15 Insurance Premium Cost Share Program”

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Agriculture**

4 Subtitle 9. Maryland Crop Insurance Premium **COST SHARE** Program.

5 2–901.

6 (a) There is a Maryland Crop Insurance Premium **COST SHARE** Program
7 which is established for the purpose of [encouraging eligible farmers to participate]
8 **INCREASING PARTICIPATION BY FARMERS IN THE STATE** in the Federal Crop
9 Insurance Program [administered by the United States Department of Agriculture]
10 **AND REDUCING A FARMER’S ECONOMIC LOSSES THAT RESULT FROM NATURAL**
11 **DISASTERS AND MARKET VOLATILITY.**

12 (b) (1) (I) The Secretary may [pay a farmer eligible to participate in
13 the Federal Crop Insurance Program not more than \$2 per acre for any Federal Crop
14 Insurance premium paid by the farmer] **PROVIDE A COST SHARE PAYMENT FOR A**
15 **QUALIFYING FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE PRODUCT PURCHASED BY A FARMER**
16 **IN THE STATE.**

17 (II) **A COST SHARE PAYMENT MADE UNDER THIS SECTION**
18 **MAY NOT EXCEED 10% OF THE NET BOOK PREMIUM, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE**
19 **FEDERAL CROP INSURANCE CORPORATION WITHIN THE RISK MANAGEMENT**
20 **AGENCY OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.**

21 (2) (I) The Department may distribute money under the Maryland
22 Crop Insurance Premium **COST SHARE** Program from funds provided in the budget.

23 (II) **THE SECRETARY SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT**
24 **TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE**
25 **GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1**
26 **OF EACH YEAR THAT PROVIDES AN ESTIMATE OF THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS**
27 **NEEDED TO PAY 10% OF THE NET BOOK PREMIUM FOR QUALIFYING FEDERAL**
28 **CROP INSURANCE PRODUCTS EXPECTED TO BE PURCHASED BY FARMERS IN THE**
29 **STATE IN THE FOLLOWING CROP YEAR.**

30 (c) (1) The Secretary may adopt regulations to implement the provisions
31 of this subtitle.

1 **(2) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2008, THE SECRETARY SHALL**
2 **ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR A FARMER'S**
3 **ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE A COST SHARE PAYMENT FOR CROP INSURANCE.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 July 1, 2007.
