Vehicle Laws - Fire and Emergency Vehicles - Single Registration Plate

- FOR the purpose of providing that the Motor Vehicle Administration is required to issue only one registration plate for a vehicle owned by a city, county, State, or federal fire department, a duly constituted volunteer fire department or rescue squad, or the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems; and generally relating to registration plates.

2 3	(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this title, when it registers a vehicle, the Administration shall issue to the owner:

5 6	$\textbf{1.} \qquad \textbf{THE} \text{ vehicle is a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle, Class F (tractor) vehicle, or Class G (trailer) vehicle; \textbf{OR}}$
7 8 9 10	2. THE VEHICLE IS OWNED BY A CITY, COUNTY, STATE, OR FEDERAL FIRE DEPARTMENT, A DULY CONSTITUTED VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT OR RESCUE SQUAD, OR THE MARYLAND INSTITUTE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEMS; and
11	(ii) Two registration plates for every other vehicle.

15 16	(b) On a vehicle for which one registration plate is required, the plate shall be attached on the:
17	(1) Front of the vehicle for a Class F (tractor) vehicle; and
18	(2) Rear of the vehicle for every other vehicle.
