3 FOR the purpose of creating a Continuing Care Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund to defray certain costs; requiring the Department of Aging to administer the 4 5 Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund separately and the 6 Comptroller to account for the Fund; providing which moneys the Fund consists of; providing for the use of the Fund; providing for the investment of moneys in 7 8 the Fund; providing that the money expended in the Fund is supplemental; 9 defining a certain term; providing for the effective date of certain provisions of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and 10 generally relating to the creation of a Continuing Care Fund. 11

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall 18 take effect on the taking effect of Chapter _____ (S.B. 6) of the Acts of the General 19 Assembly of 2007. If Section 2 of this Act takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be 20 21 abrogated and of no further force and effect. SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions 22 23 of Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2007.
