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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Reforestation – Replacing Trees Destroyed by Pest Treatments**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the purposes of the Restoration Fund in the Department  
4 of Natural Resources to include planting trees on private property to replace  
5 certain trees under certain circumstances; authorizing the use of the Fund to  
6 replace trees that were destroyed under a certain quarantine with certain  
7 exceptions; authorizing the Department to adopt regulations to implement this  
8 Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the  
9 replacement of trees in the State.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Article – Natural Resources

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Natural Resources**

5–103.

(e) (1) In this subsection, “Fund” means the Reforestation Fund.

(2) There is a Reforestation Fund in the Department.

(3) The purpose of the Fund is to finance the planting of trees on:

(I) State or other publicly owned lands located in the county and watershed in which construction projects giving rise to Fund contributions are located; **AND**

**(II) PRIVATE PROPERTY ON WHICH TREES WERE DESTROYED BY A TREATMENT TO DESTROY PLANT PESTS THAT WAS APPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.**

(4) The Department shall administer the Fund.

(5) (i) The Fund is a special, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(ii) The Treasurer shall hold the Fund separately and the Comptroller shall account for the Fund.

(6) The Fund consists of any money received from contributions by a constructing agency under subsection (d) of this section.

(7) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the Fund may be used only to:

1. Plant trees on State or other publicly owned lands located in the county and watershed in which construction projects giving rise to Fund contributions are located; [or]

2. If reforestation cannot be reasonably accomplished in the county and watershed in which the construction activity is located:

A. Plant trees on State or other publicly owned lands located in the county or in the watershed in the State in which the construction activity is located; or

1                   B. Purchase credits in, establish, or maintain a forest  
2 mitigation bank in the county or watershed in which the construction activity is  
3 located in accordance with Department regulations; **OR**

4                   **3. REPLACE TREES, EXCEPT NURSERY STOCK THAT**  
5 **HAS NOT BEEN REPLANTED, THAT WERE DESTROYED BY THE APPLICATION OF A**  
6 **TREATMENT APPLIED TO DESTROY PLANT PESTS UNDER A QUARANTINE**  
7 **IMPOSED BY THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE, WHETHER OR NOT THE**  
8 **QUARANTINE IS IN EFFECT IN THE COUNTY OR WATERSHED WHERE THE**  
9 **CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY OCCURRED.**

10                   (ii) 1. Except as provided in subparagraph 2 of this  
11 subparagraph, moneys in the Fund may be used for administrative costs calculated in  
12 accordance with § 1-103(b)(2) of this article.

13                   2. The Fund may not be used to finance administrative  
14 activities associated with a mitigation bank.

15                   3. Any credits created by the Fund may not be sold to  
16 compensate for additional forest impacts.

17                   (iii) 1. The Department shall accomplish the reforestation for  
18 which money is deposited in the Fund within 1 year or two growing seasons after  
19 project completion, as appropriate.

20                   2. Money deposited in the Fund under subsection (d) of  
21 this section shall remain in the Fund for a period of 1 year or two growing seasons,  
22 and at the end of that time period, any portion that is not used to meet the  
23 reforestation requirements shall be returned to the constructing agency.

24                   (8) (i) The Treasurer shall invest the money of the Fund in the  
25 same manner as other State money may be invested.

26                   (ii) Any investment earnings of the Fund shall be credited to the  
27 General Fund of the State.

28                   (9) Expenditures from the Fund may be made only in accordance with  
29 the State budget.

30                   **(10) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT**  
31 **THIS SUBSECTION.**

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency  
2 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,  
3 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members  
4 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from  
5 the date it is enacted.
