- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

- 16 (a) "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle that:
- 17 **(1) (I)** Has NO MORE THAN THREE WHEELS;

1	(II) 1. HAS one front wheel and one or two rear wheels		
2	POSITIONED on a single axle; OR		
3	2. HAS TWO FRONT WHEELS POSITIONED ON A		
4	SINGLE FRONT AXLE AND ONE REAR WHEEL; AND		
5 6	(III) [however, if it is] IF equipped with two rear wheels on a single axle, [the] HAS A rear tread width [may] THAT DOES not exceed 25 inches;		
7 8	(2) Is self–propelled by a motor with a rating of more than 1.5 brake horsepower and a capacity of at least 49 cubic centimeters piston displacement;		
9 10 11	(3) [Has] MAY HAVE a singular front steering road wheel mounted in a fork assembly that passes through a frame steering bearing and to which is attached a handlebar or other directly operated steering device;		
12	(4) Has a seat that is straddled by the driver; and		
13 14	(5) Except for a windshield or windscreen, does not have any enclosure or provision for an enclosure for the driver or any passenger.		
15	(b) A detachable sidecar is an accessory to and not a part of a motorcycle.		
16 17	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
