12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (1) [the] **THE** entire width between the boundary lines of any way or 18 thoroughfare of which any part is used by the public for vehicular travel, whether or 19 not the way or thoroughfare has been dedicated to the public and accepted by any 20 prepare authority: AND

20 proper authority; AND

1 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THE APPLICATION OF STATE LAWS, THE 2 ENTIRE WIDTH BETWEEN THE BOUNDARY LINES OF ANY WAY OR 3 THOROUGHFARE USED FOR PURPOSES OF VEHICULAR TRAVEL ON ANY 4 PROPERTY OWNED, LEASED, OR CONTROLLED BY THE UNITED STATES 5 GOVERNMENT AND LOCATED IN THE STATE.

⁶ SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2007.
