A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Judgeships – Circuit and District Courts**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of resident judges of the circuit courts in
4 certain judicial circuits; altering the number of associate judges of the District
5 Court in certain districts; and generally relating to judgeships in the circuit
6 courts and the District Court of Maryland.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 1–503.

16 (a) In each county in the first seven judicial circuits there shall be the
17 number of resident judges of the circuit court set forth below, including the judge or
18 judges provided for by the Constitution:

19 (15) Montgomery [21] **22**

1 (b) In Baltimore City there shall be [32] **33** resident judges of the Circuit
2 Court for Baltimore City.

4 (b) In each of the districts provided for in § 1-602 of this subtitle, there shall
5 be the following number of associate judges of the District Court:

6 (4) District 4 — [5] **6**, two to be appointed from Calvert County and
7 [two] **THREE** to be appointed from Charles County

8 (6) District 6 — [11] **12**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 July 1, 2007.
