- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2004. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of 14 September 30, 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
- 15 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]
