- 4 (4) THREE ONE SHALL HAVE GENERAL BUSINESS MARKETING
  5 EXPERIENCE IN A LIFE SCIENCES BUSINESS LOCATED IN THE STATE; AND

- 10 <u>(E)</u> A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY BOARD MAY NOT RECEIVE 11 COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY BOARD, BUT IS ENTITLED TO 12 REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL 13 REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- 14 (E) (F) (1) EXCEPT FOR THE SECRETARY, THE TERM OF AN ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER IS 2 YEARS.
- 16 **(2)** AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 18 **(3)** A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN 19 SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS 20 APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 21 (F) (G) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE AN ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER 22 FOR INCOMPETENCE, MISCONDUCT, OR FAILURE TO PERFORM THE DUTIES OF 23 THE POSITION.
- 24 (G) (H) A CHAIR SHALL BE SELECTED BY THE GOVERNOR FROM 25 AMONG THE ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS.
- 26 (H) (I) THE ADVISORY BOARD MAY ACT WITH AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF EIGHT MEMBERS.

- 19 (K) IN PERFORMING ITS DUTIES, THE ADVISORY BOARD SHALL GIVE
  20 DUE CONSIDERATION TO THE BUSINESS, SCIENTIFIC, MEDICAL, AND ETHICAL
  21 ASPECTS OF THE LIFE SCIENCES INDUSTRY.

- 23 (A) THE ADVISORY BOARD SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN
  24 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE
  25 GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR.
- 26 **(B)** THE REPORT SHALL SET FORTH ANY RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE ADVISORY BOARD AND SUMMARIZE THE ADVISORY BOARD'S ACTIVITIES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR.
