A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Laws - Registration Plates Honoring Mountain Maryland

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to develop and make 4 available a specially designed registration plate honoring Mountain Maryland; 5 specifying the vehicles that are eligible for the registration plate; requiring the 6 owner of a vehicle issued the registration plate to pay certain fees; providing for the distribution of a certain fee to the Chesapeake Bay Trust and the Maryland 7 8 Agricultural Education Foundation, Inc.; requiring the Administration to 9 consult with the Greater Allegany Business Foundation and the Garrett County 10 Economic Development Corporation on certain matters; requiring the Administration to adopt regulations; and generally relating to registration 11 plates honoring Mountain Maryland. 12

3 (A) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE GREATER ALLEGANY BUSINESS 4 FOUNDATION AND THE GARRETT COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 5 CORPORATION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE 6 FOR QUALIFYING VEHICLES A SPECIALLY DESIGNED REGISTRATION PLATE 7 HONORING THE STATEWIDE SIGNIFICANCE AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF MOUNTAIN 8 MARYLAND, COMPRISING ALLEGANY COUNTY AND GARRETT COUNTY.

9 (B) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER A 10 LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR 11 PARTNER OF A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT OWNS THE VEHICLE CONSIDERED 12 ELIGIBLE BY THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR 13 AN ORIGINAL OR SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION IF 14 THE VEHICLE IS INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:

- (1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;
- 16 (2) A CLASS B (FOR HIRE) VEHICLE;
- 17 (3) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S
 18 RATED CAPACITY OF 1 TON OR LESS;
- 19 (4) A CLASS E (FARM TRUCK) VEHICLE;
- 20 (5) A CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLE; OR
- 21 (6) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.

(C) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE
 REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE ASSIGNED A
 REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY:

(I) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE, A
 ONE-TIME FEE SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER THE
 ADMINISTRATION'S COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

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(II) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE,
 AND EACH TIME THE REGISTRATION PLATE IS RENEWED, AN ADDITIONAL FEE
 SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO BENEFIT THE CHESAPEAKE BAY TRUST AND
 THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC.

5 (2) THE ADDITIONAL FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION IS 6 NOT REQUIRED FOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE THAT IS EXEMPT 7 UNDER § 13–903 OF THIS TITLE.

8 (3) NO PORTION OF THE FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION 9 MAY BE CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE REVENUE 10 ACCOUNT FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 8–403 OR § 8–404 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(D) THE ADDITIONAL FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
 DISTRIBUTED IN EQUAL PORTIONS TO THE CHESAPEAKE BAY TRUST AND THE
 MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC.

(E) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL CONSULT WITH THE GREATER
 ALLEGANY BUSINESS FOUNDATION AND THE GARRETT COUNTY ECONOMIC
 DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ON:

17 (1) THE DESIGN OF A REGISTRATION PLATE TO BE ISSUED UNDER
 18 THIS SECTION TO HONOR THE STATEWIDE SIGNIFICANCE AND CONTRIBUTIONS
 19 OF MOUNTAIN MARYLAND;

(2) THE SETTING OF THE FEE TO BE CHARGED UNDER
SUBSECTION (C)(1)(II) OF THIS SECTION AT A LEVEL INTENDED TO ENCOURAGE
THE PURCHASE OF THE REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION
WHILE PROVIDING A CONTINUOUS REVENUE SOURCE TO BENEFIT THE
CHESAPEAKE BAY TRUST AND THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION
FOUNDATION, INC.; AND

(3) A SCHEDULE UNDER WHICH THE ADMINISTRATION WILL
TRANSFER TO THE CHESAPEAKE BAY TRUST AND THE MARYLAND
AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC. REVENUE COLLECTED ON
THEIR BEHALF.

30(F) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO GOVERN31THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
