15 (b) (1) The owner of a motor vehicle that is required to be registered in 16 this State shall maintain the required security for the vehicle during the registration 17 period.

18 (2) A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION IS AN ADMINISTRATIVE 19 OFFENSE PUNISHABLE ONLY BY THE CIVIL PENALTIES PROVIDED FOR IN 20 §17–106 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
