17	SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS IS CONDUCTED.
18	(2) REVENUE GENERATED BY THE FEE IMPOSED UNDER
19	PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE FUND
20	AND USED FOR THE PURPOSE ESTABLISHED IN \S 9–2704(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
21	(3) THE BALANCE OF ANY UNUSED PORTION OF THE REVENUE
22	GENERATED BY THE FEE IMPOSED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION
23	SHALL REVERT TO THE FUND.
24	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect

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October 1, 2007.
