4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005
5 to change the name of a grantee from the Board of Directors of the Knox
6 Community Development Corporation, Inc. to the Board of Directors of the
7 Oliver Community Association, Inc.; extending the deadline by which the
8 grantee is required to present evidence to the Board of Public Works that a
9 matching fund will be provided.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

7 **ASSOCIATION, INC.** for the planning, design,

15 **FUND WILL BE PROVIDED** (Baltimore City)..... 100,000
