Public Institutions of Higher Education – Textbook Fairness Ac

- FOR the purpose of requiring the governing board of a public institution of higher education to notify students of the textbooks assigned for certain courses on the website of the institution at a certain time; requiring that the notification contain certain information; prohibiting an employee of a public institution of higher education from receiving certain benefits in exchange for requiring students to purchase certain textbooks; and generally relating to textbooks assigned for courses at public institutions of higher education.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 19 **(A) (1) THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF** 20 **HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL NOTIFY STUDENTS OF THE TEXTBOOKS ASSIGNED**
- 21 FOR EACH COURSE OFFERED AT THE INSTITUTION BY LISTING EACH ASSIGNED

- 1 TEXTBOOK ON THE WEBSITE OF THE INSTITUTION WHEN THE COURSE
- 2 INSTRUCTOR OR ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT OFFERING THE COURSE IDENTIFIES
- 3 THE TEXTBOOK FOR ORDER AND SUBSEQUENT STUDENT PURCHASE.
- 4 (2) THE NOTIFICATION SHALL INCLUDE THE INTERNATIONAL 5 STANDARD BOOK NUMBER (ISBN) FOR EACH TEXTBOOK.
- 6 (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
  7 SUBSECTION, AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION
  8 MAY NOT DEMAND OR RECEIVE ANY PAYMENT, LOAN, SUBSCRIPTION, ADVANCE,
- 9 SERVICE, OR ANY OTHER BENEFIT IN EXCHANGE FOR REQUIRING STUDENTS TO
- 10 PURCHASE A SPECIFIC TEXTBOOK FOR A COURSE.
- 11 (2) AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 12 EDUCATION MAY RECEIVE:
- 13 (I) A COPY OF A TEXTBOOK THAT MAY NOT BE SOLD,
- 14 INCLUDING A SAMPLE COPY, INSTRUCTOR'S COPY, AND INSTRUCTIONAL
- 15 MATERIAL; AND
- 16 (II) ROYALTIES OR OTHER COMPENSATION FROM THE SALE
  17 OF A TEXTBOOK THAT INCLUDES THE WRITING OR WORK OF THE EMPLOYEE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
