- FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Somerset County to sell
   certain property known as Whittington Elementary School to Shore Up Inc.,
   under terms the County Commissioners consider appropriate; exempting the
   sale of certain property from certain general requirements for the sale of
   surplus property; and generally relating to the sale of county property in
   Somerset County.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
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## Article 25 – County Commissioners

2 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the county 3 commissioners of every county may:

4 (i) Acquire by purchase, gift, devise, bequest, condemnation, or 5 otherwise, any property, or any interest therein, of any kind needed for any public 6 purpose;

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(ii) Erect buildings thereon for the benefit of the county;

8 (iii) Sell at public sale any property when no longer needed for9 public use; and

10 (iv) Provide for the financing of any housing or housing project 11 in whole or in part, including the placement of a deed of trust, mortgage, or other 12 instrument upon the property to ensure repayment of funds used to purchase, 13 construct, rehabilitate, or otherwise develop the housing project. The authority 14 provided for in this subparagraph does not limit the existing powers of a county or 15 county commissioners.

16 (2) Property may not be sold until it has been advertised for at least 17 20 days prior to the date of sale.

(b) (1) The provisions of this subsection prevail over those of subsection(a) of this section to the extent of any inconsistency.

20 (5) (i) In Somerset County, the County Commissioners may sell 21 any interest in surplus property held by the county by acceptance of sealed bids 22 solicited by advertisement.

(ii) An advertisement for bids shall be published at least twice
in a newspaper of general circulation in the county not less than 10 days nor more
than 90 days before the date set for opening the bids.

(iii) The bids shall be opened in public and the County
Commissioners shall act on the bids only during a public session of the County
Commissioners.

(iv) If the County Commissioners determine that the highest bid
 fails to yield a reasonable price for the property, the County Commissioners may reject
 all bids on the property.

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If all bids are rejected, the County Commissioners shall 1  $(\mathbf{v})$ 2 record the highest bid in the minutes of the public session and may proceed to sell the 3 property: 4 By readvertising for sealed bids: 1. 5 2.By public auction; or 6 3. If the property is surplus school property, in accordance with paragraph (2) of this subsection. 7 The County Commissioners shall adopt a local ordinance or 8 (vi)resolution governing the sale of property under this paragraph. 9 The County Commissioners of Somerset County may sell the 10 (d) (1) property known as the old Somerset County Jail, located on 48 North Beckford 11 Avenue, Princess Anne, to the Town of Princess Anne. 12 13 (2) **(I)** THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO A 14 SALE OF PROPERTY UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH. **(II)** THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SOMERSET COUNTY 15 MAY SELL THE APPROXIMATELY 4.02 ACRES OF PROPERTY AT COUNTY TAX MAP 16 103, GRID 8, PARCEL 1467 (KNOWN AS WHITTINGTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL) 17 TO SHORE UP INC., UNDER TERMS CONSIDERED APPROPRIATE BY THE COUNTY 18 19 **COMMISSIONERS.** 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2007.
