1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Somerset County – Treasurer – Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Treasurer of Somerset County; providing
4 that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent
5 Treasurer of Somerset County; and generally relating to the salary of the
6 Treasurer of Somerset County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 25 – County Commissioners

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 25 – County Commissioners**

1 (r) The annual salary of the County Treasurer of Somerset County is
2 ~~[\$44,300]~~ **\$60,000**.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
4 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
5 the salary or compensation of the Treasurer of Somerset County in office on the
6 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
7 compensation of the Treasurer of Somerset County shall take effect at the beginning of
8 the next following term of office.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2007.
