Video Lottery Terminals - Statewide Straw Ballot

FOR the purpose of requiring that a question be placed on the ballot in the next general election of the State to determine the sense of the voters in the State on the issue of locating video lottery terminals licensed by the State for commercial gaming purposes at certain types of locations in the State; providing for the carrying out of the straw ballot; and generally relating to the holding of a straw ballot at the next general election of the State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That under the provisions of the Election Law Article, the State Board of Elections shall prepare and include on the ballot for the November general election of 2008 the following question:

"Do you support locating video lottery terminals licensed by the State for commercial gaming purposes at up to three licensed horse racetracks in the State and at up to three nonracetrack destination locations?"

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Board of Elections shall do those things necessary and proper to place this question on the ballot prepared for the November general election of 2008, so that each participating voter in the State may have the opportunity to cast a vote on the question. The question shall be proposed, presented, tallied, and reported in general accordance with the provisions of the Election Law Article. The vote on this question is advisory only.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2007.
