5 to extend the deadline by which the Board of Directors of Pyramid Atlantic, Inc.
6 may present evidence to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be
7 provided.

1 (AY) Pyramid Atlantic. Provide a grant equal to the lesser
2 of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund
3 provided, to the Board of Directors of Pyramid
4 Atlantic, Inc. for the design, construction, and
5 renovation of an elevator and attachment of a
6 welcome center to the existing Pyramid Atlantic
7 property, located in Silver Spring. Notwithstanding
8 Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may
9 consist of in kind contributions. **NOTWITHSTANDING**
10 **SECTION 1(5) OF THIS ACT, THE GRANTEE HAS**
11 **UNTIL JUNE 1, 2009, TO PRESENT EVIDENCE**
12 **THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE PROVIDED**
13 (Montgomery County)..... \$100,000

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 June 1, 2007.
