## A BILL ENTITLED

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AN	$\mathbf{A}(\mathbf{C}'\mathbf{I})$	concerning
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2	Potomac River Fisheries Commission - Employees and Retirees -
3	Participation in State Health and Welfare Benefits Program

- 4 FOR the purpose of altering the Potomac River Compact of 1958 to require that 5 retirees of the Potomac River Fisheries Commission be eligible for certain 6 health and related insurance benefits; allowing employees and retirees of the 7 commission to enroll and participate in the health insurance benefit options 8 established under the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits 9 Program under certain circumstances; requiring the commission to pay certain 10 costs to the State and make a certain determination; making this Act subject to a certain contingency; and generally relating to the participation in health 11 insurance benefit options under the State Employee and Retiree Health and 12 Welfare Benefits Program by employees and retirees of the Potomac River 13 Fisheries Commission. 14

1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
3	Article - Natural Resources
4	4–306.
5	Article I.
6	Section 7. The commission shall establish and maintain an office at such
7	locations as it may select, and may employ an executive secretary who shall serve at
8	the pleasure of the commission, and such other administrative, clerical, scientific, and
9	legal personnel as it deems necessary. The powers, duties and compensation of all
10	employees shall be as prescribed by the commission, and the employees shall not be
11	subject to the provisions of Division I of the State Personnel and Pensions Article of
12	the Annotated Code of Maryland that govern the Maryland State Personnel
13	Management System nor to the provisions of the Virginia Personnel Act, as the same
14	may be from time to time in effect. The commission may extend to any employee or
15	employees membership in the Virginia Supplemental Retirement System or the
16	Maryland Employees' Retirement System, whichever is applicable, subject to the laws
17	relating to each such retirement system. Employees AND RETIREES of the commission
18	shall also be eligible for the health and related insurance for State employees AND

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- 24 (A) AN EMPLOYEE OR RETIREE OF THE POTOMAC RIVER FISHERIES 25 COMMISSION MAY ENROLL AND PARTICIPATE IN THE HEALTH INSURANCE 26 BENEFIT OPTIONS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE PROGRAM WITH THE APPROVAL 27 OF THE COMMISSION.
- 28 (B) THE COMMISSION SHALL:
- 29 **(1)** PAY TO THE STATE THE TOTAL COSTS RESULTING FROM THE 30 PARTICIPATION OF ITS EMPLOYEES AND RETIREES IN THE PROGRAM; AND

## (2) DETERMINE THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE COMMISSION WILL SUBSIDIZE PARTICIPATION OF ITS EMPLOYEES IN THE PROGRAM.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not take effect until a similar Act is enacted by the Commonwealth of Virginia; that the Commonwealth of Virginia is requested to concur in this Act of the General Assembly of Maryland by the enactment of a similar Act; that the Department of Legislative Services shall notify the appropriate officials of the Commonwealth of Virginia of the enactment of this Act; and that upon the concurrence in this Act by the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Governor of the State of Maryland shall issue a proclamation declaring the Act valid and effective and shall forward a copy of the proclamation to the Director of the Department of Legislative Services.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
