- (B) (1) IN CONSULTATION WITH A COUNTY ASSOCIATION FOR RETIREES OF THE COUNTY BOARD, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PLAN TO PROVIDE MEDICAL, DENTAL, VISION, AND PRESCRIPTION BENEFITS TO THE INDIVIDUALS QUALIFIED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IF IT HAS A PLAN TO PROVIDE THOSE HEALTH BENEFITS TO CURRENT PRINCIPALS, TEACHERS, AND OTHER CERTIFICATED AND NONCERTIFICATED EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY BOARD.
- 10 **(2)** THE COUNTY BOARD MAY ESTABLISH DIFFERENT 11 COST-SHARING RATIOS FOR RETIREES AND FOR CURRENT EMPLOYEES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
