- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- (a) A person may not knowingly possess a film, videotape, photograph, or
 other visual representation depicting an individual under the age of 16 years:

9 10 11	(c) Nothing in this section may be construed to prohibit a parent from possessing visual representations of the parent's own child in the nude unless the visual representations depict the child engaged:
12	(1) as a subject of sadomasochistic abuse; or
13	(2) in sexual conduct and in a state of sexual excitement.
14 15	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
