A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Drug Treatment - Study of the State's Approach to Drug Treatment and the Feasibility of Communal-Setting Treatment

FOR the purpose of requiring the Director of the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to report to the Governor and to certain committees regarding the State's approach to drug treatment and the feasibility of communal–setting treatment; and generally relating to the State's approach to drug treatment.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That, on or before December 1, 2007, the Director of the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall study and report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the Senate Finance Committee and Judicial Proceedings Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee and Judiciary Committee regarding the State's approach to drug treatment and the feasibility of communal–setting treatment, including:
- 17 (1) actual drug treatment;
- 18 (2) skill training;
- 19 (3) career training; and
