4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Expedited Partner Therapy Pilot Program in the Baltimore City Health Department; providing for the purpose of the Program; 5 6 authorizing certain health care providers to prescribe, dispense, dispense or 7 otherwise provide certain antibiotic therapy to certain partners of patients 8 diagnosed with certain sexually transmitted diseases without making a certain 9 physical assessment; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene and the Commissioner of the Baltimore City Health Department to adopt jointly 10 certain regulations; establishing civil immunity for certain health care 11 providers in certain circumstances; requiring the Baltimore City Health 12 Department to report to the Governor and General Assembly regarding the 13 operation and performance of the Program on or before a certain date each year; 14 providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the 15 prevention of sexually transmitted diseases and the Expedited Partner Therapy 16 17 Pilot Program.

- 3 (E) THE SECRETARY AND THE COMMISSIONER JOINTLY SHALL ADOPT 4 REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 5 (F) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A LICENSED 6 PHYSICIAN, CERTIFIED NURSE PRACTITIONER, LICENSED REGISTERED NURSE, 7 LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE, OR CERTIFIED PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT MAY NOT 8 BE HELD CIVILLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION PERFORMED IN 9 ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION IF:

 16 BALTIMORE CITY TO THE PATIENT AT A PUBLIC HEALTH CLINIC FOR THE

18 (G) (F) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2007, AND EACH YEAR
 19 THEREAFTER, THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO
 20 THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
 21 ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ON THE OPERATION AND PERFORMANCE
 22 OF THE EXPEDITED PARTNER THERAPY PILOT PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
July 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 3 years and, at the end of June
30, 2012 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall
be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
