1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County Board of Education – Compensation**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the compensation received by certain members of the
4 Calvert County Board of Education; providing that this Act does not apply to
5 the salary or compensation of the incumbent members of the Board; and
6 generally relating to the compensation received by members of the Calvert
7 County Board of Education.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 3–303.

1 (a) At its first meeting at the beginning of each calendar year, the County
2 Board shall elect a president and a vice president from among its members.

3 (b) (1) The president of the County Board is entitled to receive [\$5,000]
4 **\$6,500** annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive
5 [\$4,000] **\$5,500** each annually as compensation.

6 (2) An elected member is entitled to health insurance benefits
7 regularly provided to employees of the Board of Education under the same terms and
8 conditions extended to other employees of the Board of Education.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
10 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
11 the salary or compensation of the members of the Calvert County Board of Education
12 in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
13 salary or compensation of the members of the Calvert County Board of Education shall
14 take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2007.
