### 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Department of Juvenile Services - Reorganization and Regionalization

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Juvenile Services to serve children in the juvenile services system with certain programming that delivers services on 4 a regional basis; establishing a certain number of operational regions in the 5 State: requiring each region to include at least a certain number of secure 6 7 facilities used solely for certain purposes; requiring each region to include a sufficient certain number of committed facilities to provide certain services to 8 9 certain children under certain circumstances; requiring each region to include a 10 nonpublic facility only under certain circumstances; authorizing 11 Department to place a child into a certain facility if a certain determination is made; requiring the Department to submit a certain plan to the Department of 12 Budget and Management on or before a certain date; and generally relating to 13 iuvenile services. 14

17	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18	October 1, 2007.
