1 AN ACT concerning

2 Election Law – Voter Registration – Change of Party Affiliation

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the period during which a registered voter may change party affiliation; repealing the provision that prohibits a voter, subject to 4 5 certain exceptions, from changing party affiliation during certain periods; 6 requiring a local board to change, under certain circumstances, a voter's party 7 affiliation at any time that registration is open; repealing the provision that 8 permits a registered voter who has moved from one county to another to change 9 party affiliation during a certain period under certain circumstances; repealing 10 the provision that prohibits an individual whose registration has been canceled from reregistering in the same county under certain circumstances with a 11 different party affiliation; and generally relating to a voter's change of party 12 affiliation. 13

SENATE BILL 363

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Election Law** 3 4 3 - 302.5 (a) Registration is closed beginning at 9 p.m. on the 21st day preceding an election until the 11th day after that election. 6 7 3 - 303. 8 [Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c)] SUBJECT TO (a) 9 SUBSECTION (B) of this section, a local board, at the signed request of a registered voter, shall change that voter's party affiliation, or change the voter to or from a 10 decline, at any time that registration is open. 11 Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, party 12 (b) (1)affiliation may not be changed: 13 14 (i) from 9 p.m. on the Monday, or the next regular business day if the Monday is a legal holiday, that is 12 weeks before the day on which a primary 15 election is to be held under § 8-201 of this article, until and including the day on 16 which the registration reopens after the primary election is held; and 17 (ii) from and including the day of issuance of a gubernatorial 18 proclamation calling a special election, pursuant to § 8-710 of this article, or from 5 19 p.m. on the next regular business day if the day of issuance is a legal holiday, until 20 21 and including the day on which that special election is held. 22 If a voter requests a party affiliation change during a period (2)[specified in paragraph (1) of this subsection] WHEN REGISTRATION IS CLOSED, the 23 local board shall make the change if: 24 25 [(i)] (1) there is sufficient evidence, as determined by the local boards pursuant to regulations adopted by the State Board, that the request was 26 mailed before the beginning of the period [specified in paragraph (1) of this 27 subsection] WHEN REGISTRATION IS CLOSED; or 28 29 [(ii)] **(2)** the request was submitted by the voter to the Motor Vehicle Administration, a voter registration agency, another local board, or the State 30

Board before the beginning of the period [specified in paragraph (1) of this subsection]
WHEN REGISTRATION IS CLOSED.

3 [(c) If a registered voter has moved from one county to another within the 4 State since the last general election, the voter may change party affiliation or change 5 to or from a decline, one time only, during a period specified in subsection (b)(1) of this 6 section.

7 (d) An individual whose registration has been canceled at the individual's 8 request within a period specified in subsection (b) of this section may not reregister in 9 the same county during the same period with a party affiliation or nonaffiliation 10 different from the previous registration.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2007.
