Retrieval of Oocytes - Prohibition

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain persons to donate oocytes subject to certain 4 limitations; prohibiting certain persons from performing oocyte retrieval in 5 order to collect oocytes to be used or donated for certain purposes; providing for 6 certain penalties for offering, soliciting, retrieving, or otherwise encouraging 7 certain persons to donate oocytes; providing that certain violations shall be grounds for the denial of any license, permit, certification, or any other form of 8 9 permission required to practice certain occupations in the State; defining a certain term; and generally relating to a prohibition against the retrieval of 10 oocytes for research purposes. 11

- 2 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "OOCYTE" MEANS THE FEMALE GERM CELL OR 3 EGG.
- 4 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON 5 MAY DONATE OOCYTES.
- 6 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT PERFORM OOCYTE RETRIEVAL IN ORDER TO 7 COLLECT OOCYTES TO BE USED OR DONATED FOR RESEARCH PURPOSES.
- 8 (D) A PERSON WHO OFFERS, SOLICITS, RETRIEVES, OR OTHERWISE 9 ENCOURAGES A PERSON TO USE OR DONATE OOCYTES FOR RESEARCH 10 PURPOSES IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO 11 IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$200,000 12 OR BOTH.
- 13 **(E)** A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE GROUNDS FOR THE
 14 DENIAL OF ANY LICENSE, PERMIT, CERTIFICATION, OR ANY OTHER FORM OF
 15 PERMISSION REQUIRED TO PRACTICE OR ENGAGE IN ANY TRADE, OCCUPATION,
 16 OR PROFESSION REGULATED BY THE STATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
