2 (b-6) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, in Dorchester 3 County an additional Class A beer license may be issued for any premises licensed 4 under a Class B [beer license], **CLASS C**, or Class D [beer license or beer, wine and 5 liquor] license.

6 (2) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF DORCHESTER 7 COUNTY MAY LIMIT THE NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL CLASS A BEER LICENSES 8 THAT IT ISSUES.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2007.
