Vehicle Laws - Motorized Wheelchairs and Scooters - Guidelines

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to develop and 4 update, on or before a certain date and in consultation with certain community 5 organizations for individuals with disabilities, guidelines for the appropriate 6 use on streets of motor-driven wheelchairs, scooters, and other devices designed 7 to provide mobility assistance for individuals with disabilities; requiring the 8 Administration to provide for the distribution of the guidelines, including 9 distribution through certain community organizations; and generally relating to the development, updating, and distribution of guidelines relating to the 10 appropriate use of certain wheelchairs, scooters, and other devices on streets. 11

 10 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- 11 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF 12 THE GUIDELINES ADOPTED AND UPDATED UNDER THIS SECTION, INCLUDING 13 DISTRIBUTION THROUGH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH 14 DISABILITIES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
