1 (f) "Professional corporation" means a corporation organized under this 2 subtitle for the purpose of rendering professional services.

3 (g) (1) "Professional service" means a service that may lawfully be 4 rendered only by a person licensed or otherwise authorized by a licensing unit in the 5 State to render the service and that may not lawfully be rendered by a corporation 6 under the Maryland General Corporation Law.

7 (2) "Professional service" includes, but is not limited to, a service 8 provided by:

9	(i)	An architect;

- 10 (ii) An attorney;
- 11 (iii) A certified public accountant;
- 12 (iv) A chiropractor;
- 13 (v) A dentist;
- 14 (vi) An osteopath;
- 15 (vii) A podiatrist;
- 16 (viii) A physician;
- 17 (ix) A professional engineer;

18 (x) A licensed real estate broker, licensed real estate
19 salesperson, and licensed associate real estate broker;

- 20 (xi) A veterinarian; [and]
- 21 (xii) A psychologist; AND
- 22 (XIII) A PHYSICAL THERAPIST.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 October 1, 2007.
