1	(1) destroy the handgun;
2	(2) sell, exchange, or transfer the handgun to another law enforcement
3	agency for official use by that agency;
4	(3) sell the handgun to a retired police employee in accordance with §
5	2–415(c) of this article; [or]
6	(4) sell the handgun to the law enforcement officer to whom the
7	handgun was assigned; OR
8	(5) SELL, EXCHANGE, OR TRANSFER THE HANDGUN TO A
9	MANUFACTURER.
10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11	October 1, 2007.
