CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education – Dual Enrollment Grant Program**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain money carried forward from a previous fiscal
4 year to be used for dual enrollment grants, in addition to certain other financial
5 aid programs; repealing certain provisions of law relating to the inclusion of
6 dually enrolled students in a certain part-time grant program; requiring the
7 Maryland Higher Education Commission, in cooperation with certain
8 institutions of higher education, to establish and administer a grant program
9 for dually enrolled students; requiring a recipient of a dual enrollment grant to
10 be a resident of the State ~~and~~, be a dually enrolled student, and demonstrate
11 financial need; providing that, for courses completed under the program, a
12 recipient of a dual enrollment grant is not required to receive credit from a
13 secondary school and an institution of higher education at the same time;
14 requiring the Commission to ~~administer funds for the Dual Enrollment Grant~~
15 ~~Program and to distribute funds to an institution of higher education on behalf~~
16 ~~of a dual enrollment grant recipient~~ allocate funds to an institution of higher
17 education based on the number of dually enrolled students receiving credit for
18 certain courses; requiring funds for the Dual Enrollment Grant Program to be
19 as provided in the annual budget of the Commission by the Governor; requiring
20 the Commission to establish guidelines for the awarding of dual enrollment
21 grants to dually enrolled students; requiring the Commission to adopt certain

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Education**

23 18-107.

24 (b) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this title, money appropriated
 25 under this title that is not used by the end of the fiscal year may not revert to the
 26 State Treasury.

27 (2) All money retained under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall be
 28 used to make awards to students during subsequent fiscal years as provided in §§
 29 18-301, 18-706(f), 18-1401, **18-14A-01**, and 18-1501 of this title and § 13-613(d)(1)
 30 of the Transportation Article and may not be used for administrative expenses.

32 (a) In this section, “part-time student” means a student who is[:

1 (1) Enrolled] **ENROLLED** in a degree-granting program at an eligible
 2 institution and taking at least 6 but no more than 11 semester hours of courses each
 3 semester[; or

4 (2) Dually enrolled in a secondary school in the State and an
 5 institution of higher education].

6 (b) [(1)] In cooperation with the institutions of higher education in the
 7 State, the Commission shall establish and administer a grant program for
 8 undergraduate part-time students.

9 [(2) Each institution of higher education that participates in the grant
 10 program shall establish criteria for awarding a grant or waiver to dually enrolled
 11 students.]

12 (c) A recipient of a part-time grant shall:

13 (1) Be a resident of the State; and

14 (2) [(i)] Have demonstrated a definite financial need according to
 15 criteria established by the Commission[; or

16 (ii) Be a dually enrolled student].

19 (A) **IN THIS SECTION, "DUALY ENROLLED STUDENT" MEANS A**
 20 **STUDENT WHO IS DUALY ENROLLED IN:**

21 (1) **(I) A SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE STATE; OR**

22 **(II) A PROGRAM OF SECONDARY SCHOOL INSTRUCTION IN**
 23 **THE STATE; AND**

24 (2) **AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE.**

25 (B) **THE IN COOPERATION WITH INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION**
 26 **IN THE STATE, THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER A GRANT**
 27 **PROGRAM FOR DUALY ENROLLED STUDENTS.**

1 (C) A RECIPIENT OF A DUAL ENROLLMENT GRANT SHALL:

2 (1) BE A RESIDENT OF THE STATE; ~~AND~~

3 (2) BE A DUALY ENROLLED STUDENT; AND

4 (3) DEMONSTRATE FINANCIAL NEED ACCORDING TO CRITERIA
5 ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION.

6 (D) FOR COURSES COMPLETED UNDER THE PROGRAM, A RECIPIENT OF
7 A DUAL ENROLLMENT GRANT IS NOT REQUIRED TO RECEIVE CREDIT FROM A
8 SECONDARY SCHOOL AND AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AT THE
9 SAME TIME.

3 **UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL PROVIDE THE COMMISSION WITH AN ANNUAL**
4 **AUDIT OF THE USE OF THE FUNDS.**

5 ~~SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, beginning with the fiscal~~
6 ~~year 2009 State budget and each year thereafter, the Governor shall appropriate to~~
7 ~~the Maryland Higher Education Commission for the administration of the Dual~~
8 ~~Enrollment Grant Program established under Title 18, Subtitle 14A of the Education~~
9 ~~Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, an amount not less than 10% of the amount~~
10 ~~appropriated to the Commission for the administration of the Part Time Grant~~
11 ~~Program established under Title 18, Subtitle 14 of the Education Article.~~

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before November 1,
13 2007, the Maryland Partnership for Teaching and Learning PreK – 16 Council shall
14 provide the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government
15 Article the General Assembly, a comprehensive list of recommendations that will
16 surmount barriers to dual-enrollment and will facilitate dual-enrollment
17 opportunities.

18 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 June 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the
20 end of June 30, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
21 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
