Lodging Establishments - Individuals with Disabilities - Reservation of Rooms to Facilitate Emergency Rescue

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring lodging establishments with a certain number of rooms 5 for guests to reserve a certain number of accessible rooms for individuals with 6 disabilities until a certain time and on a certain floor of the lodging 7 establishment in order to facilitate emergency rescue of individuals with 8 disabilities; requiring certain staff of the lodging establishment to offer certain 9 rooms to individuals with disabilities; requiring lodging establishments to 10 establish a certain emergency rescue procedure and to provide certain training to personnel; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 11 accommodation of individuals with disabilities in lodging establishments. 12

- 1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 2 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 3 (2) "ACCESSIBLE ROOM" MEANS A ROOM IN A LODGING
 4 ESTABLISHMENT CONSISTENT WITH THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT
 5 ACCESSIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES.
- 6 (3) "FRONT DESK STAFF" INCLUDES A MANAGER, ASSISTANT
 7 MANAGER, CONCIERGE, DESK CLERK, OR ANY OTHER MEMBER OF THE STAFF OF
 8 A LODGING ESTABLISHMENT WHO KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO KNOW THAT AN
 9 INDIVIDUAL WITH A DISABILITY WHO REQUIRES AN ACCESSIBLE ROOM IS
 10 CHECKING INTO THE LODGING ESTABLISHMENT.
- 11 (B) THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION APPLY ONLY TO LODGING 12 ESTABLISHMENTS WITH 50 OR MORE ROOMS FOR GUESTS.
- 13 (C) IN ORDER TO FACILITATE THE EMERGENCY RESCUE OF
 14 INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES, EACH LODGING ESTABLISHMENT SUBJECT TO
 15 THIS SECTION SHALL RESERVE ONE ACCESSIBLE ROOM FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH
 16 DISABILITIES:
- 17 (1) UNTIL ALL OTHER SLEEPING ROOMS ARE OCCUPIED OR THE ROOM IS RENTED TO AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A DISABILITY; AND
- 19 **(2)** ON THE LOWEST FLOOR OF THE LODGING ESTABLISHMENT 20 THAT HAS ROOMS FOR GUESTS.
- 21 **(D) FRONT DESK STAFF SHALL:**
- 22 (1) FIRST OFFER AN ACCESSIBLE ROOM ON THE LOWEST FLOOR
 23 OF THE LODGING ESTABLISHMENT THAT HAS ROOMS FOR GUESTS, IF
 24 UNOCCUPIED, TO AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A DISABILITY WHO REQUIRES AN
 25 ACCESSIBLE ROOM BEFORE OFFERING THE INDIVIDUAL A ROOM ON ANOTHER
 26 FLOOR; AND
- 27 (2) NOTE THE USE OF A ROOM ON ANY FLOOR BY AN INDIVIDUAL
 28 WITH A DISABILITY WHO REQUIRES AN ACCESSIBLE ROOM IN ORDER TO ADVISE
 29 EMERGENCY PERSONNEL OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S LOCATION IN THE EVENT OF
 30 EVACUATION.

I (F.)	EACH LODGING ESTABLISHMENT SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL:

- 2 (1) ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY RESCUE PROCEDURE FOR 3 INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES WHO ARE GUESTS OF THE LODGING 4 ESTABLISHMENT; AND
- 5 (2) TRAIN PERSONNEL OF THE LODGING ESTABLISHMENT ON 6 HOW TO BEST ASSIST INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES IN THE EVENT OF 7 EVACUATION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2007.
