3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain individuals to donate oocytes under certain circumstances; making certain medical histories available to certain children 4 5 and certain parents or guardians; requiring certain consent for certain donations indicating certain acceptance; prohibiting certain compensation for 6 certain donations; authorizing certain reimbursement for certain expenses 7 8 related to certain donations; providing for certain penalties for certain 9 compensation of certain persons under certain circumstances; defining a certain 10 term; and generally relating to the donation of oocytes.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "OOCYTE" MEANS THE FEMALE GERM CELL OR 2 EGG.
- 3 (B) (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, AN 4 INDIVIDUAL MAY DONATE OOCYTES.
- 5 (2) THE MEDICAL HISTORY OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DONATES 6 OOCYTES SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO:
- 7 (I) CHILDREN CONCEIVED USING THE DONATED OOCYTES; 8 AND
- 9 (II) THE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS OF CHILDREN 10 CONCEIVED USING THE DONATED OOCYTES.
- 11 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DONATES OOCYTES UNDER THIS SECTION
 12 SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN CONSENT FOR THE DONATION INDICATING
 13 ACCEPTANCE OF THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION.
- 14 **(D) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS**15 **SUBSECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DONATES OOCYTES MAY NOT RECEIVE**16 **COMPENSATION FOR THE DONATION.**
- 17 **(2)** AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DONATES OOCYTES MAY RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE DIRECT EXPENSES INCURRED AS A RESULT OF THE DONATION PROCEDURE.
- 20 **(E)** A PERSON WHO OFFERS TO COMPENSATE OR COMPENSATES AN 21 INDIVIDUAL TO ENCOURAGE THE DONATION OF OOCYTES IS GUILTY OF A 22 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT 23 EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
