20	(I) THAT THE PROVIDER DOES NOT PARTICIPATE ON THE
21	PROVIDER PANEL OF THE ENROLLEE'S CARRIER; AND
22	(II) OF THE ANTICIPATED TOTAL CHARGES FOR THE
23	HEALTH CARE SERVICES.
