Food Containing Artificial Trans Fat – Prohibition

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing for the types of foods that contain artificial trans fat; 4 prohibiting certain schools, certain institutions of higher education, and certain 5 food establishments from storing, distributing, holding for service, using in 6 preparation of certain menu items, or serving food containing artificial trans 7 fat; providing for the applicability of this Act to certain penalties; and generally 8 relating to the prohibition on the use of artificial trans fat in public schools, 9 public institutions of higher education, and State-owned or State-operated food 10 establishments.

13 [(a)] (B) Any person who violates any provision of Subtitle 3 of this title or 14 any rule or regulation adopted under Subtitle 3 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor 15 and on conviction is subject to:

- (1) Is liable for a civil penalty not exceeding \$5,000, to be collected in a
 civil action in the District Court for any county; and

[(c)] (D) Each day on which a violation occurs is a separate violation under
 this section.
